CALL TO ORDER:

Commissioner Graham opened the regular Planning Commission meeting to order at 6:02 PM

ROLL CALL:

Planning Commission present: Commissioner Graham, Commissioner Haberstroh, Commissioner Torgerson, and Commissioner Morris. Commissioner Haberstroh motioned to excuse Commissioner Hollinger, seconded by Commissioner Morris. Vote on Motion 3 aye, 0 nay.

Commissioner Morris motioned to forward Mobile Food Vendors code on to city council, seconded by Commissioner Torgerson. Vote on motion 3 aye, 0 nay.

Commissioner Haberstroh stated that the Funtime Festival seemed like it worked out alright.

Director Morris stated that they will be moving forward with making the RC park a permanent fixture at the park. **Commissioner Graham** concurred with the positive feedback about the Funtime Festival.

CITIZEN COMMENT:

Jerry Nixon - Apex Concrete - was curious about the traffic and the roundabout by Love's.

Director Morris stated that the roundabout is a requirement for the TA project, if TA doesn't come in then, then the roundabout isn't required.

Jerry Nixon – Apex Concrete – Also had concerns regarding the speed limit at the east side of exit 71.

Director Morris stated that he needs to speak with WSDOT, the City of Napavine doesn't have jurisdiction over that area. The city has attempted in the past to put a 35-mph sign in that area and WSDOT quickly removed it.

Commissioner Haberstroh has noticed more presence with the Police Department, it is a good feeling.
